SEED SUPPLY OVERVIEW

Winterkill & prevent plant have created seed supply challenges for many cover crop species. We encourage you to plan & secure seed now for a busy fall. Here is an overview:

- Oats, peas/oats, spring barley & summer annuals (millets, sorghum x sudangrass, sudangrass, teff) are largely unavailable industry-wide
- Winter rye, oat & radish supply is currently tight, but should improve after new crop harvest mid-August (our new Nitrous winter triticale will be available in Sept.)
- Products currently in good supply (partial list):
 - Forage grasses (annual/perennial/intermediate ryegrass)
 - Mixes (cover crop & forage mixes)
