



Rebounder Tall Fescue

- · Excellent turf quality with early spring green-up
- Stress & drought tolerant
- Aggressive tillering & rhizomes
- Superior wear tolerance
- High density

Rebounder (Pick W43 Festuca arundinacea) turf-type tall fescue is very different from other tall fescues currently available, and is a step in a new direction for this turf species. It demonstrates high wear tolerance and fast recovery, coupled with high turf performance. Whether it is planted on a golf course, sports field, dog park or home lawn, Rebounder exhibits superior turf quality and performance. The parent plants of Rebounder were selected from the survivors after extensive wear pressure, and demonstrated good recovery during summer heat so this variety will bounce back from adversity. Drought resistance helps it stay green longer and recover more quickly.

Rebounder ranks among the highest turf quality varieties in all growing zones, and under different management programs. This is a dark green, fine textured variety with high turf density. Under severe brown patch pressure it shines due to superior resistance. The high seedling vigor and aggressive, early tillering makes it ideal for all turf uses but in particular for repair seeding of multi-use and high traffic turf sites.

Rebounder is adapted for all uses from golf course roughs to parks, sports fields, sod farms and home lawns. With its high stress resistance it is persistent and has excellent turf quality, with fine leaf texture and high density for superior overall appearance.

USES: Lawns, athletic fields, commercial sites, slopes, parks, reclamation sites. Ideal in sun or shade or limited water.

IDENTIFICATION: Deep rooted, cool season perennial bunchgrass. Grows from tillers. Leaf blades are glossy on the underside/serrated on margins. Leaf blades may be wide with rolled vernation (stem), blades smooth on turf-type, coarse on others.

ESTABLISHMENT: Slow, but not as slow as bluegrass. Needs plentiful water to establish, then very drought tolerant.
